- Install AVL (Audio, Video and Theatrical Lighting) systems in performance venues and commercial buildings.
- Train clients and provide on-site service to existing AVL equipment.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Install, maintain, troubleshoot and repair AVL systems.
- Hang, using entertainment industry best practices, all manner of AVL systems.
- Accurately and timely document quality standards, system anomalies and project work
- Maintain installation shop area.
- Work with building and electrical contractors.
- Assist Production Dept. on events periodically.

SKILLS

- Ability to read and understand CAD schematics and construction documents.
